Then we'll continue to Ouarzazate, known as the "Gateway to the Desert" and famous for its film studios where blockbusters like Gladiator were filmed. Next, we'll head to the peaceful oasis of Skoura, a lush paradise filled with palm trees and ancient kasbahs.

We'll visit the fascinating Kasbah Amridil, a perfectly preserved fortress that showcases incredible Berber traditions and centuries-old architecture. As the sun sets, you'll check into a cozy lodge surrounded by nature and tranquility – the perfect place to relax after a day of adventure!

## Day 4: Skoura to Merzouga

Later, we'll head to Khamlia village for a soulful Gnaoua music show that reflects deep local roots. We'll serve you medfouna, a special dish from this region that's absolutely delicious! If you're craving more desert fun, we can arrange additional camel rides at sunset/sunrise or set up an exhilarating quad bike or buggy ride across the dunes.

## Day 6: Erfoud to Fes

After breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to the desert as we travel through the beautiful Ziz Valley, passing through Errachidia and the charming mountain town of Midelt. The journey offers spectacular views that change from desert landscapes to lush valleys and cedar forests.

Along the way, we'll stop in the magnificent cedar forests near Ifrane, Morocco's "Little Switzerland," where you'll have the chance to see the playful Barbary macaques (monkeys) in their natural habitat – don't forget your camera for these cheeky little characters!

You'll arrive in Fes, Morocco's spiritual and cultural capital, and settle into your comfortable riad. Spend your free time wandering the city's vibrant streets and discovering its incredible energy at your own pace.

## Day 7: Exploring Fes

Today you'll dive deep into the fascinating world of Fes! You'll begin your day with a guided tour where our knowledgeable local guide will share the city's captivating stories and cultural treasures with you.
